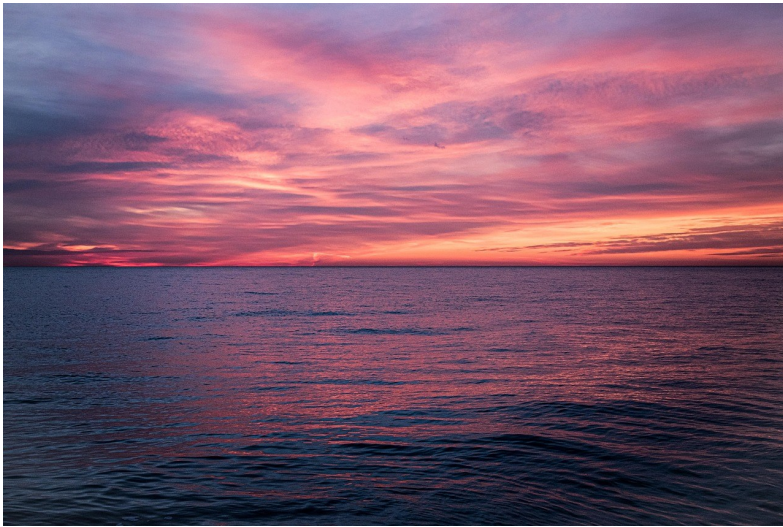


Cheadle Hulme Methodist Church
